

COOKIE POLICY

Cookies: what are they? Which we use and for what purpose?

www.sweethome.cat uses own and third party cookies. Cookies are small files created in the user's browser whose purpose is to exclusively remember user preferences (language, country, login, browser features, website usage information, etc.), and / or To recognize the registered users to allow them a more fluid and personalized navigation.

They can also be used to obtain information about the date and time of the user's last visit, measure some traffic parameters within the site itself and estimate the number of daily visits made, in order to focus and adjust services more effectively. The user should keep in mind that data on the movements and uses of the website are collected as statistical and anonymous, non-personal data.

The user, by the mere fact of browsing and continuing to use the website, consent to the use of the cookies that will be discussed below, as well as the present Cookies Policy.

Cookies present at www.sweethome.cat:

PHPSESSID	Own	These cookies are used in the PHP encrypted variables of SESSION follow the web server. These cookies are essential in the web.	Sesión
_ga	Third parties (Google Analytics)	These cookies are used to distinguish users.	2 years
_gid	Third parties (Google Analytics)	These cookies are used to store and update a unique value for each page visited	1 day

_gat	Third parties (Google Analytics)	They are used to differentiate between the different tracking objects created in the session. The cookie is created when loading the javascript library and it does not exist una versió prèvia de la cookie _gat. The cookie is updated each time you send the data to Google Analytics	10 minutes from the creation or modification
_atuvc	Own	It is associated with the widget AddThis to share content on social networks	2 years
Cookie_notice_accepted	Own	It is used to memorize that the user who has accessed the web page has accepted the cookies policy.	1 month

Allow, block or delete cookies

The present website does not require the installation of cookies. The user may not accept them or configure their browser to block them, if necessary, remove them. In the web browser the user can find the necessary security instructions to carry out these actions. Examples:

- If you use Microsoft Internet Explorer, in the menu option Tools> Internet Options> Privacy> Settings.

- If you use Firefox, in the menu option Tools> Options> Privacy> Cookies.
- If you use Google Chrome, in the menu option Configuration> Privacy
- If you use Safari, in the menu option Preferences> Security

You can use the "Help" section in the toolbar of most browsers to change the settings of your computer, but some of the features of the services offered on the web may not work or may be more complicated or glasses to access if all cookies are rejected.

Many browsers allow you to activate a private mode by which cookies are always deleted after your visit. Depending on each browser, this private mode can have different names, below you can find a list of the most common browsers and the different names of this "private mode":

- Internet Explorer: InPrivate
- FireFox: Private Browsing
- Google Chrome: Incognito
- Safari: Private Browsing
- Opera: Private Browsing

Please read carefully the help section of your browser to learn more about how to activate "private mode". You can continue to visit our website even if your browser is in "private mode", however, the user experience may not be optimal and some utilities may not work.
